Spring Clean up will be on Monday May 12th and Tuesday May 13th. **We are asking you to make three separate piles. This is very important.** You risk not having your things picked up and being billed by private contractor if not taken care of.

▶ **White goods and scrap metal.** Only stoves, water heaters or other metal objects that contain no freon. We will not pick up propane tanks, refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or freon containing items.*

▶ **Garden & yard waste.** All garden and yard waste must be bagged and the bags contain only garden and yard waste (grass clippings, small twigs, leaves etc.). Please remember that these bags must be lifted up and over the side of the truck. If you cannot lift them up 5 feet, neither can our village crew. Please make the bags lighter if necessary. No loose leaves or debris should be in the street gutters to block the flow of water to the storm drains.

▶ **Large household waste.** This includes furniture, carpets, bedsprings, mattresses, TV's, etc.

We cannot and will not pick up: tires, construction and demolition materials, recyclables or any hazardous waste such as paint, gas cans or gas grill propane tanks. No refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers or other refrigerants.*

The Town of Manchester (Corner of Route 96 & County Road 7) will take old tires for a charge of \$2.00 per tire. The hours to bring them are Monday & Wednesday 4-7pm and Saturday 9am-4pm. Tire coupons can be purchased at the Town office. *Refrigerants will be accepted until the end of June. Telephone: 289-3010

The schedule for Spring pick up is as follows:

MONDAY, MAY 12TH: Main Street, Merrick Avenue, Lehigh Avenue, Gilligan Drive, Bennett Avenue, Smith Place, Smith Terrace, Pratt Road, Howard Street, Wilson Street, Moses Road, Vanderwall Drive, Center Street, Clifton Street (West of Outlet), State Street.

TUESDAY, MAY 13TH: North Avenue, South Avenue, Clifton Street (East of Outlet), Newton Street, Edgemere Drive.

This spring pick up is a service for **Village residents only**. Non-village residents using this service will be subject to prosecution.
