The purpose of this report is to provide information about the quality of water and services we provide for you. You are encouraged to stop by and pick one up.

🚫 **OUTDOOR BURNING PROHIBITED** We have received complaints of residents burning their garbage in outdoor burning barrels. Not only is the odor offensive, it is illegal to do so. The State Fire Prevention Code part §1191.2 prohibits outdoor burning without being legally authorized by the Fire Department and Code Enforcement Official and to be conducted in conformity with forest fire control regulations. If you are burning and do not have legal authorization to burn outdoors, you are in violation of the law. Continued burning may constitute legal action. Please discontinue outdoor burning for the protection and consideration of our neighbors and for our environment.

From the Dept. of Public Works: FREE MULCH is available at the Village Barns (located on Vanderwall Drive, just off of Center Street).

The mulch is from grinding the ice storm tree branches and is available to any village resident who would like any. Feel free to stop there and get some.

We will pick up brush from the curbside on Fridays. Leaves must be bagged* and branches are to be no more than 10 ft in length with a diameter of no more than 5 inches. Please place branches in an orderly manner in one direction. *Mark your calendar that you can start raking your leaves to the curb (not in the gutter) the week before Halloween, as we will start the leaf vacuum at that time for the season.

Our **Summer Recreation Program**, located at the Manchester Family Park, off Merrick Avenue, on West Street, is in progress and will continue through August 15th. Stop at the park for details.
