LEAVES... The Village crew has begun to pick up loose leaves from the curbside and will continue to do so until Friday, November 18th, weather permitting. **The last day to place your loose leaves at the curb is Thursday November 17th**, after that all leaves will have to be bagged for pick up. Please remember to rake them near the curb, not in the road where they can block the flow of water drainage. **THERE WILL BE NO BRUSH PICK UP AFTER NOV. 17TH NO BAGGED LEAF PICK UP AFTER NOV. 28TH UNTIL RESUMING ON APRIL 1ST.**

... PARKING: The following will be **strictly enforced:** Our local law on snow removal goes into effect **on November 1st until April 1st stating that NO PARKING is permitted on all village streets between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM.** At no time is parking permitted over village sidewalks. Please note that the Village is not responsible for any damaged mailboxes or posts.

As stated in the August Newsletter, a new sewer rate is now in effect.

Sewer Minimum: from \$65.00 to \$70.00 for the first 15,000 gallons of water used.

Sewer Overage: For each 1500 gallons over 15,000 gallons, the rate will increase from \$6.50 to \$7.50 per 1500 gallons used.

MANCHESTER PEDESTRIAN / BICYCLE PATHWAY TRAIL
