**LEAVES...** The last day to place your loose leaves at the curb is **Thursday November 14th**, after that all leaves will have to be bagged for pick up. Please remember to rake them near the curb, not in the road where they can block the flow of water drainage. **THERE WILL BE NO BRUSH PICK UP AFTER NOV. 21<sup>st</sup> NO BAGGED LEAF PICK UP AFTER NOV. 29<sup>th</sup> UNTIL RESUMING IN APRIL 2014.** We will pick up Christmas trees from Dec. 26<sup>th</sup> to Jan. 18<sup>th</sup>.

**PARKING:** Our local law on snow removal goes into effect on **November 1<sup>st</sup> until April 1<sup>st</sup>** stating that **NO PARKING is permitted on all village streets between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM.** At no time is parking permitted over village sidewalks.
