LEAVES... The last day to place your loose leaves at the curb is **Thursday November 21st**, (weather permitting) after that all leaves will have to be bagged for pick up. Please remember to rake them near the curb, not in the road where they can block the flow of water drainage. **THERE WILL BE NO BRUSH PICK UP AFTER NOV. 21st. NO BAGGED LEAF PICK UP AFTER NOV. 29TH UNTIL RESUMING IN APRIL 2020.** We will pick up Christmas trees from Dec. 26th to Jan. 26th.

ALL OBSTACLES (SHRUBS, LANDSCAPING TIMBER, ORNAMENTAL GADGETS) ALONG THE SIDEWALKS MUST BE PLACED OR TRIMMED 1 FOOT FROM THE EDGE SO THE SIDEWALK PLOW HAS CLEARANCE. HEDGES AND SHRUBS WILL BE REMOVED BY THE DPW IF NOT TRIMMED BACK.

PARKING: Our local law on snow removal goes into effect on **November 1st until April 1st** stating that **NO PARKING is permitted on all village streets between the hours of 2:00AM and 6:00AM.** At no time is parking permitted over village sidewalks.
