CENSUS 2010 ACTIVITIES UPDATE

July 2010 – Census takers continue to visit households that did not return a questionnaire by mail. The Census Bureau may call or visit a small percentage of households to clarify answers, confirm geographic location of responses, verify vacant or nonexistent households, and resolve duplicate addresses. **December 2010** – By law, the Census Bureau delivers population counts to the President for apportionment. **March 2011** – By law, the Census Bureau completes delivery of redistricting data to states. TRAIL UPDATE

Our trail along the outlet will be going out to Bid for construction soon. All permanent easements have been acquired. Due to new NYS sign requirements, signage needs to be re-approved by Department of Transportation but shouldn't take long. It has been a long process, but the success of a beautiful trail should be very rewarding.

HIGHWAY GARAGE ADDITION

A public hearing was held on July 12th for the demolition and addition to our highway garage on Vanderwall Drive. The old garage was deemed unsafe to occupy. The Village will be obtaining a serial bond for \$255,000 to be paid over a five year period. Upon completion, we will invite you to an open house of the facility.

NYS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION ROAD AND BRIDGE REPLACEMENT

The New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) is undertaking two projects in our area. **Summer 2010** is replacing pavement on Route 21 from Canandaigua to Route 96 in Manchester. **Summer 2011** is a project currently scheduled for construction to commence on the NY Route 96 Bridge over the Canandaigua Outlet in the Town of Manchester. This is the bridge near Friendly Village. The Bridge will be closed for about four months to remove and replace the bridge deck. The proposed posted detour consists of NY Route 21, Outlet Road and County Road 7. Local roads will be open to normal traffic and access to properties along the closed section of NY 96 will be maintained.

FROM THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER

Many summer projects may require a building permit. Please contact me to see if a permit is necessary before you begin. This includes swimming pools two feet high and over, hot tubs, decks, sheds, fences, and roofs (just to name a few). All of which are regulated by building codes.
