The enclosed February 1st water & sewer statement is covering the last quarter of the year 2020. It is due by February 20th without penalty. All arrears and payments after Feb. 20th must be made by April 14th, 2021, after which time we forward any unpaid water & sewer to Ontario County to be relieved upon property taxes.

A reminder letter will be sent.



Please remember that cars must be kept off the streets from 2:00am to 6:00am (from November 1st to April 1st) to allow the snowplows clear access to remove the snow. You may be ticketed and/or the car will be towed away.



When removing snow from driveways & sidewalks, it is prohibited to plow or shovel snow from your property into the public streets.

Please note that, by Highway Law 319, the Village is not responsible for replacing broken or damaged mailboxes. Unfortunately broken mailboxes do happen. It is usually the weight of ice and snow that breaks them.
